- Tour of Eckington Manor Cookery School, restaurant and grounds.

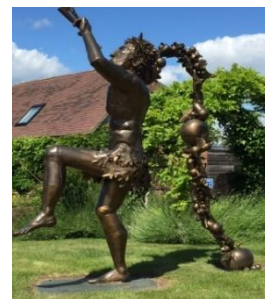
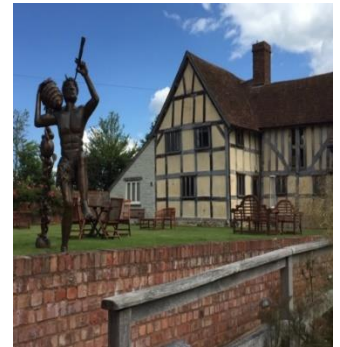
